Carmel Water District 12 – Well Pump #1

The Lake Mahopac and Lake Casse Park District Advisory Boards and the Town of Carmel Recreation Director, Jim Gilchrist for Sycamore Park/Long Pond has requested that a geese removal operation be performed in accordance with our United States Department of the Interior, Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) Migratory Bird and Depredation Permit.

This Department requested quotes from wildlife management providers and only the attached quote was received a summarized:

The number of birds allowed to be removed, per the permit, is not to exceed 150. The method of harvesting the geese is provided in the attached proposal and the harvesting sites will be arranged with the various contacts at the respective sites.

However per Jim Gilchrist, this service was not included in the 2019 budget. To round up and remove non-flying Canada Geese up to the limit set on the Fish and Wildlife Permit from Lake Mahopac, Long Lake and Lake Casse.

Scope of Work;

The birds will be caught off the lake, corralled in pens, crated and delivered to a poultry processor in Stuben County, NY. The round up will take place in late June 2019.

Lake Mahopac:

We will use 3-4 different captures sites on Lake Mahopac to corral and capture the birds. The
birds will be herded up using kayaks, canoes and gas powered 12-foot rowboats.

Long Lake & Lake Casse:

The Town of Carmel Engineering Department (Department) and the Lake Mahopac Park District Advisory Board (LMPDAB) have received a New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) permit to stock 700 Triploid Carp (carp) in Lake Mahopac. It should be noted the NYSDEC permit, is set to expire on November 30, 2019.

As part of the permit, the NYSDEC provides a list of approved carp suppliers in our region. Ed Barnett of the LMPDAB contacted three (3) of the suppliers on the list and received quotes from the following two (2) suppliers:

- KEO Fish Farm (AK) -\$5,150 (700 fish)
- Rowledge Pond Aquaculture (CT) \$7,102.00 (670 fish)

Please note that a request for the purchase of 700 fish was made to both suppliers, KEO only raised the price by \$150.00.

Per the attached there are sufficient funds in the Lake Mahopac Park District budget to purchase the carp.

We therefore recommend the purchase of the carp from KEO Fish Farm at the price pf \$5,150.00.

I respectfully request that this matter be placed on the next available work session for discussion.

Dear Mr. Schmitt:

Enclosed is your 2019 Permit to Stock Triploid Grass Carp in Lake Mahopac. We have fully considered the monitoring reports, letters, and issues brought up during the meetings and conferences calls with you and others concerned about the control of the nuisance levels of aquatic vegetation at Lake Mahopac.

As we have discussed, we feel we are lacking some key information for us to confidently issue a permit for the additional 1,750 triploid grass carp you have requested in your May letter. Given the data we have been supplied to date, we feel comfortable issuing a permit to stock up to 700 triploid grass carp (TGC) this summer. I would be happy to discuss with you in further detail how we arrived at this number, but for the sake of brevity, I have provided the paragraph below.

In summary, we used a stocking rate of 10 TGC per acre for the expanded vegetation of 204 acres measured in 2017. This results in a target population of 2,040 triploid grass carp, with the goal of substantially reducing, but not eliminating, the submerged aquatic vegetation in Lake Mahopac. The TGC population target of 2,040 fish, minus the estimated existing number of 1,346 TGC (using a 90% survival rate) equals 694 TGC (or approximately 700) for a permit issued in June 2019.

Please be aware of the Special Conditions that are included in this permit. Regardless of whether you stock triploid grass carp early this summer, this fall, or early next spring (2020), we will need to wait until after the monitoring report following the 2021 growing season is completed to assess if additional stocking of triploid grass carp in Lake Mahopac is appropriate at that time.

If a decision is made to wait for stocking until the results from the 2019 vegetation monitoring is complete, a more refined number to stock can be calculated and the permit can be revised based on the newest information.

Best of luck with the lake this year.

Additional Permit Conditions for Permit to Stock Triploid Grass Carp 3-19-088 Lake Mahopac, Town of Carmel, Putnam County

- 5. The approved fish barrier, as specified in your original Triploid Grass Carp Stocking Permit (#3-94-53), must remain installed at the Lake Mahopac outlet. This barrier must be monitored and maintained on a regular basis as long as there are Triploid Grass Carp present in the lake.
- 6. Before any additional Triploid Grass Carp stocking may occur, a thorough assessment of the aquatic vegetation and water chemistry of Lake Mahopac must be conducted following two full growing seasons (2020 and 2021), including (at a minimum) the following:
 - a) Ten transects, as identified in the Full Environmental Assessment Form (1993) will be sampled to determine species of aquatic vegetation present, their density and extent of coverage. Each transect will be perpendicular to shore and extend from the shore to the outermost extent of aquatic vegetation.
 - b) Along each transect, a deep water, shallow water and mid depth sample of vegetation will be taken. Each sample will cover at least one-quarter square meter or bottom. Vegetation will be separated as to species and weighed.
 - c) A map shall be made locating the above sampling points. This map should also be constructed in such a way as to show changes in species composition, abundance (acreage) and density from one sampling period to another. To most effectively accomplish this, acreage of vegetation and percent composition of each species/type of vegetation should be mapped as polygons and also reported in a table.
 - d) Water samples collected at a depth of 1.5 meters in the deepest part of the lake shall be analyzed for nitrate, nitrogen, total phosphorous, chlorophyll a, color, pH, temperature, dissolved oxygen, and secchi disc transparency.
 - e) In order to stay consistent with previous studies at Lake Mahopac all of these preceding samples and analyses shall be made as close to the second week of August as possible.

The as-built survey work for the Long Pond Road (LPR) project has been completed.

This information is required by legal counsel to finalize the road improvement district in order to determine where the road encroaches on private properties. These property encroachments will warrant additional survey information to be collected to further identify the metes and bound of these encroachments of property.


Once the metes and bounds and descriptions are determined the Town will advise the property owners that they will have to either voluntary convey the property interests in fee simple absolute to the Long Pond Road Improvement District or the Town will have to undertake eminent domain proceedings.

Per the surveyor, the final survey (attached) reveals ten (10) properties where the road encroaches and four (4) parcels where easements (presumably drainage and road-maintenance-related) are needed.

The quote for the work is \$350 per description for a total of \$4900.00. Legal counsel has already ordered and received the updated property searches for owner and liens so as to finalize the appropriate property-interest conveyance documents once the descriptions are provided.

Per the attached there are sufficient funds in the C248 budget to fund this work.

This Department requests that the Town Board authorize this request and that this request be placed on the next Town Board work session.
