TOWN BOARD MEETING TOWN HALL, MAHOPAC, N.Y.

A Regular Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Carmel was called to order by Supervisor Michael Cazzari on the 3rd day of April 2024 at 7:03 p.m. at Town Hall, 60 McAlpin Avenue, Mahopac, New York. Members of the Town Board present by roll call were: Councilman Kearns, Councilwoman McDonough, Councilman Lombardi and Supervisor Cazzari.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was observed prior to the start of official business and a moment of silence was held to honor those serving in the United States Armed Forces and for NYPD Police Officer Jonathan Diller and his family. Officer Diller was tragically murdered in New York City.

Supervisor Cazzari read the following statement:



It is the Board's understanding that there are many people in attendance this evening who may wish to speak about and/or to express the objections to a particular project that is currently pending before the Planning Board.

While this Board certainly encourages public interest and input in community development as well as public involvement and participation in the approval process, please understand that on the advice of counsel, there will be no comment or discussion relating to this matter this evening or at any time before the Town Board. The Planning Board is an independent and autonomous approval entity that makes its decisions and determinations based solely upon the record before it and without any input or influence whatsoever from the Town Board or its members.

We encourage all of those residents and stakeholders who have in interest in speaking on this or any other application before the Planning Board, Zoning Board or Environmental Conservation Board to attend those meetings and take the opportunity to have their voices heard during the course of the scheduled public hearings.

Thank you.

Supervisor Cazzari added that he was referencing the Planning Board meeting on April 11th when this application will come before them. Supervisor Cazzari said that the reason the Town Board is not involved is because the Planning Board is separate from the Town Board. Town Board members cannot be seen as influencing that Board's decision. This would only lead to litigation and undue cost to the tax payers by having to fight something that could have been avoided by not allowing such discussions.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Michael Nowak, Carmel resident, asked if the Planning Board are advisory to the trustees or are they an independent approval authority.

Town Attorney Gregory Folchetti responded that the Planning Board is an independent approval authority.

Supervisor Cazzari added that the Zoning Board and the Environmental Conservation Board are also independent approval authorities. Each board has their own approval authority, autonomous from the Town Board.

The following Town of Carmel residents spoke in opposition of the lithium battery farm project and spoke of their concern that they could not offer public comment on this topic at tonight's meeting: Lauren Rosolen, Michael Nowak, Dr. Carrie Riordan, Gina Gorman, Jody Canariato and Louise Kennedy.

Supervisor Cazzari stated that this topic would not be discussed tonight. He said that the Planning Board will have a public hearing just like the Town Board has public hearings. Public comment will be heard on the matter at that public hearing.

Mr. Nowak requested proposed code changes for the town code regarding public notice requirements which he feels are not appropriate and are lacking. He said that a multitude of projects before various boards are not properly noticed and a 24×36 sign is not adequate for people driving 30 mph because of the height and legibility of the letters. He asked if the mail notice requirements and public notices for future projects could be revamped for the Planning Board, Zoning Board, Architectural Review Board and Environmental Conservation Board.

Mr. Nowak requested a moratorium on the lithium battery farm project.

Somers residents Lisa Circelli, Scott Morello and Kevin O'Keefe were informed by Supervisor Cazzari that public comment is for Town of Carmel residents or business owners.

Dr. Carrie Riordan, Carmel resident, asked where she could find the information on the lithium battery farm project.

Supervisor Cazzari stated that the Planning Board will be having a meeting on April 11th and the agenda will be on the website.

Supervisor Cazzari explained that the Planning Board is separate from the Town Board. The Town Board members do not advise the Planning Board to approve or disapprove and they do not provide input. He added that there is a process that is followed and if either party is unhappy with the ruling, it is not that the Town Board had any influence.

Gina Gorman, Carmel resident, asked who oversees the Planning Board and does the Planning Board have the ultimatum on all items that come before them.

Supervisor Cazzari explained that there are zoning codes, state law and state regulations that the Planning Board follows.

Tara Ferdico, Carmel resident, said that it is great that the residents of Carmel and Somers are coming together for the betterment of the community.

Supervisor Cazzari stated that the public can share their comments at the April 11th Planning Board meeting.

Councilwoman McDonough stated that she just received confirmation that this item is not on the Planning Board agenda for April 11th. She also said that she was told that the public hearing has not been scheduled yet.

Christopher Harrigan, Carmel resident, said that he understands that there are certain rules and procedures that must be followed. He said that there is a room full of people at tonight's meeting that are willing to learn about the process and this could be a good opportunity to educate everyone.

Supervisor Cazzari thanked him for his comments.

Supervisor Cazzari wanted to clarify that the members of the Town Board do not want to be dragged into a lawsuit and let undue pressure go and that is why they cannot discuss this topic.

When comments continued on this topic, Supervisor Cazzari requested that the microphones be turned off.

Louise Kennedy, Carmel resident, asked if the decision for this project will be made by the Planning Board before the people have the opportunity to voice their concerns. She also asked Supervisor Cazzari who would sue him.

Supervisor Cazzari thanked her for her comments and responded that any one may sue if they do not get their way.

Supervisor Cazzari asked the residents to refrain from speaking out from the audience.

Sal Cognetta, Carmel resident, voiced his concern on how the residents were treated at this meeting.

Supervisor Cazzari thanked Mr. Cognetta.

Frank Ciano, Carmel resident, suggested to the residents to contact their Senators and Assemblymen regarding this project and also to attend all meetings.

Supervisor Cazzari thanked Mr. Ciano.

Good Morning,

Recently members of our department have proposed a bylaw change in an effort to be able to accept more members into the department. We have proposed a bylaw change to allow non-residents of our fire protection district to join as active members. Our current bylaw reads as follows:

Article VI - Membership Section 3 - Non-Resident Member Current

Any person not less than seventeen (17) years of age nor more than sixtyfive (65) years of age whose place of employment is within the Mahopac Fire Protection District and who has been so employed for a minimum of twelve months preceding the date of application, may join the Department as a Nonresident Active Member. All rules and regulations of the Department must be adhered to in order to continue membership in the Department except for the residency requirement. 12/03/87

Our certificate of incorporation states that the corporation "proposes to set within the Town of Carmel, County of Putnam, and State of New York, therefore we feel removing the protection district residency requirement to allow for us to accept members within the Town of Carmel is a simple inhouse bylaw change.

However, we have also recently had people express interest in joining from outside the Town of Carmel, even potentially outside of Putnam County. Based on experience with previous Supervisors and Town Boards we feel prior to entertaining this and expanding the Active membership requirements beyond the Town of Carmel we need an interpretation of the meaning of the word vicinity as referenced in Not-for-profit corporation Law Section 1402 Fire Corporations.

The definition of vicinity is a surrounding, adjacent, or nearby area. We felt this required a mileage limitation placed on it that would allow for a reasonable response time, As you will see in the proposed bylaw below we interpret it as being defined as residence or the location of their usual occupation is within four and a half (4.5) road miles travel distance to the Mahopac Volunteer Fire Dept. Headquarters, 741 Route 6, Mahopac, N.Y., by using electronic mapping.

Not for profit corporation Law Section 1402 Fire Corporations states:

- (c) Appointment of firefighters.
- (3) In towns outside of villages and fire districts, the consent of a majority of the members of the town board to the formation of a fire corporation shall constitute an appointment of the persons named in the certificate of incorporation as town firefighters. Thereafter, other eligible persons may be elected as members pursuant to the by-laws of the fire corporation, but the election of a member must be approved by the town board of each town which consented to the formation of the fire corporation. Such a person shall be a resident of the territory specified in the certificate of incorporation or of territory outside such boundaries which is afforded fire protection by the fire corporation pursuant to a contract for fire protection under which a cash consideration is received by the corporation or for which negotiations for renewal of such a contract are pending. The membership of any volunteer member shall terminate when he or she ceases to be a resident of such inside or outside territory, except that the corporation may authorize his or her continued membership where he or she notifies the secretary of the fire corporation (a) that he or she plans to change his or her residence to a territory which is not in such inside or outside territory, and (b) that by reason of his or her residence in the vicinity or his or her usual occupation he or she will be available to render active service as a volunteer firefighter in either such inside or such outside territory. Voting for such authorization shall be pursuant to the by-laws. Such authorization shall not become effective unless approved by resolution of the town board of each town which consented to the formation of the corporation. Any membership so continued shall terminate when the member can no longer meet the requirements of this subparagraph. A person who cannot meet the residence requirements of this subparagraph may be elected to membership as a volunteer member if by reason of his or her residence in the vicinity or his or her usual occupation he or she will be available to render active service as a volunteer firefighter in such inside or outside territory

(Cont.)

The proposed change to the bylaws is as follows:

Section 3 - Non-resident Member Requirements

A. A person, not less than seventeen (17) years of age nor more than sixty five (65) years of age, may be admitted to active membership, in accordance with Article VI, Section 4 if their residence or their place of employment is in the vicinity, as per New York State Not for Profit Corporation Law 1402, provided the roster does not show a full membership and, the non-resident member roll does not exceed forty five percent (45%).

B. Vicinity is defined as their residence or location of their usual occupation is within four and a half (4.5) road miles travel distance to the Mahopac Volunteer Fire Dept. Headquarters, 741 Route 6, Mahopac, N.Y., by using electronic mapping, as determined by the committee in Article VI, Section 4. For place of employment, the committee shall procure a document from the applicant's employer that he/she will be available to render active service and respond during work hours to fire alarms and/or ambulance calls.

C. Such member shall be entitled to all active member privileges as long as long as they continue to reside or be employed at the location at the time of their application or if they relocate to a residence or place of employment that will meet Sub-section B, above.

D. A member, who was admitted to membership as a non-resident, under Article VI, Section 3, who fails to continue to meet the vicinity requirement of Sub-section B, is dropped from the rolls.

Although we have two other stations on the outlying boarders of our protection district, we chose Headquarters because of the possibility to accept EMS only members who would need to respond to Headquarters.

Since the Town Board has to approve the roles of the Mahopac Volunteer Fire Department in order to extend the Worker's Compensation Benefits to our members, we feel it is important to seek your interpretation and approval for the above change so that in the event individuals names with addresses outside of the Town of Carmel come before you, you are aware that this is why.
