

TOWN BOARD SPECIAL MEETING
TOWN HALL, MAHOPAC, N.Y.

A Special Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Carmel was called to order by Supervisor Michael Cazzari on the 9th day of February 2022 at 7:04 p.m. at Town Hall, 60 McAlpin Avenue, Mahopac, New York. Members of the Town Board present by roll call were: Councilman Baranowski, Councilman Lombardi, Councilwoman McDonough, Councilman Schanil, and Supervisor Cazzari.
