TOWN OF CARMEL
PROPOSED LOCAL LAW # _____ OF THE YEAR 2018
A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 52 OF THE TOWN CODE
OF THE TOWN OF CARMEL, ENTITLED "BINGO"

SECTION 1

This Local Law shall be known as Amendments to Chapter 52 entitled "Bingo."

SECTION 2

Chapter 52 of the Town Code of the Town of Carmel, specifically §52-6 is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 52-6. Prizes

A. Single prizes. No prize in any single game of bingo shall exceed the sum or value of the amount set forth in General Municipal Law section 479 (5).

B. Series of prizes. No series of prizes on any one bingo occasion shall aggregate more than the sum or value of the amount set forth in General Municipal Law section 479 (6).

SECTION 3 HOME RULE

Nothing in this Local Law is intended, or shall be construed (a) to limit the home rule authority of the Town under State Law to limit the Town_s discretion in setting fees and charges in connection with any applications requiring Town approval.

SECTION 4 SEVERABILITY

If any part or provision of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part or provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this Local Law or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances, and the Town Board of the Town of Carmel hereby declares that it would have passed this Local Law or the remainder thereof had such invalid application or invalid provision been apparent.

SECTION 5 Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

At said Public Hearing, all interested persons shall be heard on the subject thereof. The Town Board will make every effort to assure that the Public Hearing is accessible to persons with disabilities.
