



Town Hall Fuel Dispensing System Electrical Trench

As the Board is aware the existing gas dispensing system, while functioning to dispense gasoline, has a failed fuel management system. In September 2014 the Board approved a total of \$32,201.14 for Conklin Services and Construction (Conklin) to upgrade the gas dispensing system and Sullivan data to install internal cable wiring to connect the system to our server.

In January 2015, the Engineering Department made the necessary arrangements for Conklin to install the new dispenser system (i.e., alternate gas supply during shut down, training, etc.) as provided in the attached email. Conklin's intention was to use the existing electrical conduit, however existing site conditions did not allow for the use of this conduit.

In order to have the new gas dispensing system installed a trench will need to be excavated to install the necessary electrical conduit for the system. This Department has received five (5) proposals to dig the electrical trench and install three (3) 1 ½ inch conduits. The results are as follows:

Contractor	Total price
Stuart Bates Inc.	\$8,750.00
Kuck Excavating	\$9,400.00
D.E.W. Construction	\$10,260.00
Conklin Services and Construction	\$10,996.00
Yonkers Excavating	\$23,213.62

The lowest proposal received was from Stuart Bates at a value of \$8,750.00. A copy of Stuart Bates Inc. proposal is attached. In addition, the electrical wire for the system will cost an additional \$1,650.00 as provided in the attached Conklin Services and Construction estimate.

Therefore the total cost for excavating the trench, installing conduit and wire is \$10,409.00.

This Department spoke with the comptroller who indicated that there is \$5,423.00 available in the building improvement line and that the remaining (\$4,986.00) could be transferred from the contingent line. A copy of the correspondence is provided in the attached email.

This Department recommends that the excavation project be awarded to Stuart Bates and that electrical line be awarded to Conklin Services and Construction and Sullivan Data Management for \$8,759.00 and \$1,650.00, respectively.

I respectfully request that this matter be placed on the next available work session for discussion.

In the fall of 2014 the homeowners 472 and 480 Kennicut Hill Road, who are provide water service via a main located on Woodland Court contacted the Engineering Department (Department) to complain about discolored water at their residence. Upon further investigation it was determined the single two (2)-inch service line for these residences was the original galvanized pipe which should have been replaced during the Carmel Water District 8 (CWD 8) water line system upgrade.

In February of 2015 the Engineering Department solicited RFP for water line replacement work in (CWD 8). This work will replace a the two (2) inch galvanized service line with two (2) - one (1) inch copper lines. This Department received the following two (2) responses to the proposal:

ContractorTotal priceBee and Jay Plumbing\$ 24,500.00Legacy Supply\$130.660.00

The lowest responsible proposal was from Bee and Jay, the operators of CWD 8 at \$23,500.00. A copy of the Bee and Jay proposal is attached.

This Department contacted the Comptroller's office who advised that are insufficient funds existing to complete this work (see attached email). The Comptroller indicated that there are sufficient funds in the CWD 8 Unreserved Fund Balance. However, because of the YTD expenditures CWD #8 has exhausted most of the 2015 Budget future work will most likely require funds to be transfer from the fund balance to cover additional costs for the remainder of the year.

This Department recommends that work be awarded to Bee and Jay Plumbing \$24,500.00 and recommend that this matter be placed on the next Town Board work session for discussion.

Carmel Water District #8 has experienced a tremendous amount of emergency repairs this year \$79,661 - 2015 YTD, \$34,681 - all of 2014, as well as an increase in contractual repairs \$34,837 - 2015 YTD and \$36,169 - all of 2014. CWD #8 does have \$124,020 in its unreserved fund balance but because of the YTD expenditures CWD #8 has exhausted most of its 2015 Budget and we will need to most likely transfer from the fund balance to cover additional costs for the remainder of the year.

Carmel Water District #8 has the highest water rates - \$8.75 per 1000 gallons and \$65.60 per 1000 CF. This district also saw a tax increase of 30% mostly because of the increase in annual debt payments due to the \$2MM water main replacement capital project.

With that being said....if authorized by the Town Board the costs to fund the water line replacement of \$23,800 mentioned below will have to be transferred from the fund balance. This district will also most likely see another tax increase in 2016 to replenish some of the fund balance.
