The contract for Landfill maintenance was awarded to Coviello's Landscaping by resolution of the Carmel Town Board. The award was made as follows:

Year 2014- \$20,000.00

Year 2015- \$15,000.00

Year 2016- \$15,000.00

After internal discussions by this Department, it was decided that a better result in elimination of vegetation would be achieved if cutting were performed in August instead of the specified window of April 15-July 1. Rain in July caused a significant increase in the vegetation from July to mid-August. Coviello has submitted the following request for additional compensation (attached). The basic premise of Coviello's position is that if he cut the landfill during the prescribed time period, the hours spent would have been significantly less. We reviewed the Certified Payrolls submitted by Coviello which identifies a significant difference in payroll hours spent from 2014 to 2015.

Coviello is requesting a change order of \$5,000.00. Based upon our evaluation, we recommend that a change order of \$2,500.00 be authorized. Attached please find Change Order number one. We request that the Board authorize that the Change order be signed by Supervisor Schmitt.

Please take into consideration the following request. The bid for job entitled "Incinerator Hill" was sent out in the spring of 2014, our bid of \$15,000.00 (\$20,000.00 the first year, \$15,000.00 for following years) annually was chosen as the winning bid. The forecast in 2014 allowed for the job to be finished within the allotted time of months May-July; which was outlined in the original contract with the town of Carmel, New York.

The summer of 2015 did not allow for the job to be completed within May-July. Initially the site hadn't appeared to be growing as usual, due to lack of rain. The job was re-scheduled per Rob Vera, to be completed in August 2015. Upon arrival to the job site on August 17, the area had become extremely over grown, with almost double the amount of foliage.

The purpose of this letter is for the request of an additional \$5,000.00 for the competition of the job. The job was completed within the suggested time period. However, due to the breach of contract ("Job shall be completed between 05/15 and 07/01.....") on behalf of the town of Carmel, the additional \$5,000.00 is to cover the extra expenses inflicted. Many over-grown areas required multiple cuts, trimming and supplemental equipment, in addition to extra man-power.

In closing, while we understand it is not always typical to request additional finances for a signed agreement; in our opinion it is a necessary petition.

SCOPE:

This is a cooperative effort among Westchester County and its political subdivisions (Cities, Towns, Villages, Fire Districts, School Districts, etc.) to:

- 1. Establish a contract as contractor's primary offering to Westchester County and its political subdivisions.
- 2. Achieve cost savings for vendors and government agencies through a single bid process that eliminates the need for multiple government bids and multiple responses by vendors.
- 3. Combine the requirements of government agencies regionally to achieve cost effective pricing.

DELIVERY POINT:

Delivery point shall be designated by the municipality or political subdivision. Each municipality or political subdivision shall be responsible for its own delivery points, orders and invoices. Contractor is instructed to deal individually with the political subdivision on these matters.

DELIVERY:

Delivery shall be expressed in number of calendar days required to make delivery after receipt of a purchase order. Deliveries must be made to the political subdivision within thirty (30) days of the contractor's receipt of order. The contractor must notify the political subdivision at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance of shipment so that necessary arrangements can be made. If deliveries cannot be effected within the stated time after receipt of order, the political subdivision must be advised immediately to facilitate any purchase from an alternate source of supply.

Delivery shall be made in accordance with instructions on Purchase Order from each political subdivision. If there is a discrepancy between the purchase order and what is listed on the contract, it is the contractor's obligation to seek clarification from the ordering agency and, if applicable, from the Bureau of Purchase and Supplies.

PAYMENT

All purchase and payment transactions shall be made directly between the Contractor and ordering agency.

PRICE:

Prices include all customs duties and charges and are net, F.O.B. destination any point in Westchester County as designated by the ordering agency including unloading at point of use.

NOTE TO CONTRACTOR:

Contract Award Notification is not an order. Do not take any action under this contract except on the basis of purchase order(s) from the political subdivision.

TERM OF CONTRACT AND RENEWAL:

The initial term of Contract shall be one year. Westchester County shall have the right in its best interest to renew Contract for up to three (3) additional one (1) year periods. If the County elects to renew Contract, the County will provide notice to Contractor ninety (90) days prior to the expiration date of Contract. Failure to notify Contractor within this time period shall not operate as a waiver of County's right to renew Contract. Within ten (10) Business Days of receiving such notice, Contractor shall submit a signed renewal to County. Each renewal shall be on the same terms and conditions as the prior term.

At the end of the initial term or any renewal Contractor shall, at the County's written request for an additional partial term, provide services as specified in Contract for a period not to exceed six (6) months under the same terms and conditions as the prior term.

CANCELLATION FOR CONVENIENCE:

The County retains the right to cancel this contract, in whole or in part without reason provided that the Contractor is given at least thirty (30) days notice of its intent to cancel. Any such cancellation shall have no effect on existing political subdivisions agreements, which are subject to the same 30 day discretionary cancellation or cancellation for cause by the respective political subdivision.

CONTRACT QUANTITIES:

Unless otherwise stated in the Specifications, unit prices shall not vary, notwithstanding any increase or reduction in the quantities of Goods or Services requested by the political subdivision, and no claim for damages shall be made by or allowed to Contractor by reason of such increase or reduction.

This is a Requirements Contract unless specifically stated otherwise, and the estimate of quantities of the Goods or Services required is approximate and shall in no respect be deemed a guarantee.

- a. The quantities actually required to complete the Contract may be less or more than estimated, and, if less, then no action for damages or lost profits shall accrue to Contractor.
- b. If the quantity (ies) varies from original estimated number or amount, then the Contract Price shall be adjusted accordingly.

Even if this is not a Requirements Contract, the County shall have the right to increase or reduce the quantity of Goods or Services by up to ten percent (10%) thereof.

REPORT OF CONTRACT PURCHASES:

A quarterly report listing totals by the full list pricing and totals by the net sales pricing shall be submitted to the Bureau of Purchase and Supplies on or before the fifteenth of the month following each quarter of the contract period.

The report is to be submitted to the Bureau of Purchase and Supplies, 375 Executive Blvd., Elmsford, NY 10523 to the attention of Dianne Munro and shall reference the contract, contract number, sales period, and contractor's name.

Failure to submit the required report may be cause for contract cancellation and disqualification of contractor for future contracts.

NOTE TO AUTHORIZED USERS:

When placing purchase orders under the contract(s), the authorized user should be familiar with and follow the terms and conditions governing its use which usually appear at the end of this document. The authorized user is accountable and responsible for compliance with the requirements of public procurement processes. The authorized user must periodically sample the results of its procurements to determine its compliance. In sampling its procurements, an authorized user should test for reasonableness of results to ensure that such results can withstand public scrutiny. The authorized user, when purchasing from County contracts, should hold the contractor accountable for contract compliance and meeting the contract terms, conditions, specifications, and other requirements.

BID SUBMISSION:

Do not make any change to the documents of this IFB. All bidders are required to submit Bid Submissions in response to the same terms and conditions. Attempts to make changes to the IFB documents may render a Bid Submission non-responsive. Changes to the IFB documents by others are not binding on the County. Bidders
