# TOWN BOARD MEETING TOWN HALL, MAHOPAC, N.Y.

A Regular Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Carmel was called to order by Supervisor Kenneth Schmitt on Tuesday, the 11<sup>th</sup> day of February 2014 at 7:46 p.m. at Town Hall, 60 McAlpin Avenue, Mahopac, New York. Members of the Town Board present by roll call were: Councilman Schneider, Councilman Lupinacci, Councilwoman McDonough and Supervisor Schmitt. Councilman Lombardi was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was observed prior to the start of official business. A moment of silence was held to honor those serving in the United States Armed Forces.

Supervisor Schmitt apologized for the late commencement of the meeting. He stated that he and Councilman Lupinacci had just returned from a meeting with the Putnam County Legislature's Protective Services Committee at the Putnam County Office Building in regard to the funding of the Putnam County Emergency Response Team (ERT).

Councilman Lupinacci explained that although the Town Board supports the Putnam County ERT, a dialog has been started with the Putnam County Legislature to ensure that the Town of Carmel taxpayers do not continue to bear more than their fair share of the expenses in connection therewith. A brief discussion ensued.
