Supervisor Schmitt explained that the Town Board decided to waive the aforementioned fee because the Putnam County Golf Course is owned and operated in part by Putnam County, and that the licenses for the golf course are held by Putnam County.

Councilman Schneider added that he voted in favor of waiving the fee because the lease that Putnam County has for the facility is incentive based. The better the facility does, the more money goes back to the Putnam County taxpayers.

PUBLIC COMMENTS - AGENDA ITEMS

No member of the public wished to comment at this time.

TOWN BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS - AGENDA ITEMS

No member of the Town Board wished to comment at this time.

OPEN FORUM - PUBLIC COMMENTS

Brianna Post spoke regarding the need for a community center to provide recreational services to the children in the Town of Carmel.

Councilman Schneider spoke regarding past and renewed efforts to bring a YMCA to the Town of Carmel. He invited Ms. Post to provide her contact information to participate in an advisory committee to be established. He explained that due to the costs involved, a Town of Carmel Recreation and Parks facility is being dual tracked as a long-term project along with a YMCA.

Councilman Lombardi added that there is a Parks and Recreation Master Plan that calls for a community center to be built at Sycamore Park and that the Town of Carmel has obtained a grant to prepare the drawings and studies associated with it. He stated that the parking lot has been paved at Sycamore Park in anticipation of things to come when the economy improves.

Councilwoman McDonough noted that plans for the facility were available for viewing at the Recreation and Parks Department at Sycamore Park. Discussion ensued.

Scott Friedman expressed his frustration with issues in connection with rate increases imposed on Carmel Water District #2 residents by the City of New York. He stated that it is important that the excessive rates are challenged and offered to represent the Town on a pro bono basis to commence an action to do so. Mr. Friedman asked that he be invited to discuss the matter at a future Work Session.

Supervisor Schmitt stated that the issue was a subject of proposed litigation.

Gregory Folchetti, Legal Counsel explained that the mechanics of proposed litigation undertaken by the Town Board and choosing any attorney to do so is typically done in executive session. The authorization with regard to the litigation would need to be done by resolution at a public session if and when the Town Board decides to do so.

Mr. Folchetti continued that for the last twelve or thirteen years, there has always been representation by the Town at the hearings held and generally a letter of protest submitted to challenge the rates set by the New York City Water Board for Carmel Water District #2. He believed that the mechanics of the proposed litigation was something that the Town Board was considering for a general discussion in executive session at their next meeting and if they choose to move forward with any action with whomever they decide upon, it would be authorized by resolution at a public meeting.

Mr. Friedman requested that the matter be a publically discussed agenda item.

Councilman Schneider stated that he would not be comfortable discussing who would legally represent the Town as well as any other strategy in connection with the matter, in a public forum. However, he did not oppose public discussion in contemplation of action. Councilman Schneider expressed his appreciation to Mr. Friedman for his offer to represent the Town and asked him to put it in writing and send to the Town Board along with his qualifications.

Mr. Friedman inquired why the Town Board is not addressing the YMCA that was proposed for the property sold by the Town located in the hamlet of Carmel.

Councilwoman McDonough stated that the matter has been addressed and is a subject of litigation.

Mr. Friedman inquired what the litigation was concerning. Discussion was held.

Mr. Folchetti clarified that there is a contract for the sale of the property between the Town and a vendor that also had an option contract with the YMCA of Greater Danbury to purchase a piece of property. The timeframe in the Town's contract with the vendor did not mirror the timeframe in the YMCA's contract with the vendor. Currently there is a dispute as to whether certain rights of the Town have triggered as a result of the passage of time.

Councilman Schneider emphasized that the Town Board is still researching other avenues to bring a community center to the Town of Carmel.

Mr. Friedman stated that certain actions taken by the Town Board in executive session have compromised the community's interest.

Councilwoman McDonough disagreed and pointed out that Mr. Friedman is presently running for the office of Putnam County legislator.

OPEN FORUM - TOWN BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Councilwoman McDonough announced that the Mahopac Volunteer Fire Department will be holding a golf tournament on September 9, 2013 at the Putnam County Golf Course.

Supervisor Schmitt added the golf tournament kicks off the fire department's 100th year anniversary celebration festivities.

Supervisor Schmitt announced that the Town of Carmel's 2013 Concert Series continues tomorrow, August 22, 2013 at the Mahopac Chamber Park with Hooked on Dixie performing old Dixieland favorites.

ADJOURNMENT

All agenda items having been addressed, on motion by Councilman Lombardi, seconded by Councilman Schneider, with all Town Board members present in agreement, the meeting was adjourned at 7:57 p.m.
