SUPPEME COURT OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between the undersigned, the attorneys and all parties to the above-entitled action, that whereas no party hereto is an infant or incompetent person for whom a guardian has been appointed and no person not a party has an interest in the subject matter of the action, that this action is hereby disposed of as follows:

- The plaintiffs hereby withdraw and discontinue with prejudice the pending action herein, including its right or entitlement to all forms and/or branches of relief sought therein.
- 2. That Plaintiffs shall be permitted to connect their property at 33 Sunset Ridge Road, Town of Carmel, Tax Map No. 44.9-1-19 ("subject parcel") to the Town of Carmel Sewer District #2 Collection System immediately upon otherwise properly completing and submitting an Application for Connection to Sanitary Sewer to the Town of Carmel Engineering Department.
- 3. In connection with said Application for Connection to Sanitary Sewer, the plaintiff shall pay to defendant the sum of \$18,367.95 (eighteen thousand three hundred sixty seven and 95/100) for capital charges incurred in connection with the subject parcel to the Town of

Carmel. Such amount shall be deemed full satisfaction of all capital charges due and payable for the subject parcel through and including the date of this Stipulation and Order.

- 4. That the Town of Carmel and its Town Assessor shall hereby be authorized and directed to immediately reduce the Capital Unit Valuation pursuant to Town of Carmel Town Code § 119-10 as assigned to the subject parcel to a total of 2.0 (Two and zero tenths) units.
- 5. That the Use Unit Valuation for the subject parcel as calculated pursuant tot Town of Carmel Town Code § 119-3 and assigned to the subject parcel shall remain unchanged and not be affected by any portion of this Stipulation and Order.
- 6. That the terms of this Stipulation and Order shall become null and void in the event that the subject parcel, wither owned by plaintiffs or their heirs, successor, and/or assigns is hereby utilized for any purpose other than single-family residential use. The foregoing shall apply to any change of use permitted by virtue of planning board approval, and/or a use variance or Zoning Board of Appeals interpretation which allows the subject property to be used for anything other than single-family residential purposes.
- 7. That the number of capital units assigned to the subject parcel shall not change in the event the parcel is legally subdivided, unless (i) the subdivision results in the creation of an additional lot or lots; and (ii) a residence(s) is building on the newly-created lot(s); and (iii) application(s) are made to connect any such residences to the Carmel Sewer District #2 facilities. In such event, the capital units assigned to the

subject parcel shall be the lesser of the amount determined by applying the formula in existence at the time of subdivision or the amount provided in paragraph #4 of the stipulation. Any new lots created which are improved and seek connection to Carmel Sewer District #2 facilities shall
