Prior to voting, Councilwoman McDonough stated that she usually does not support change orders, however after researching the matter, she would be voting in favor of the resolution for the safety of the residents.

PUBLIC COMMENTS - AGENDA ITEMS

Michael Barile addressed the creation of the job classification of Senior Account Clerk in the Engineering Department and the promotional appointment of Donna Esteves. PUBLIC COMMENTS - OPEN FORUM

Tilde Zimmerman, Highridge Road resident inquired why Carmel Highway Department personnel and vehicles were utilized to remove a tree at the home of Supervisor Schmitt on June 1, 2017. Ms. Zimmerman maintained that the tree was beyond the Town's right-of-way and within Supervisor Schmitt's property frontage. She concluded that other residents would be compelled to hire a third party company to remove the same tree.

Supervisor Schmitt responded that the Highway Superintendent made the determination that the tree was dead and in the right-of-way, and that it was the Town's responsibly to take it down. Supervisor Schmitt pointed out that many dangerous trees are taken down by the Highway Department throughout the course of the year and that limbs from this particular tree have been falling on to the travel portion of the roadway. Discussion ensued regarding the matter.
