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# **PUBLIC COMMENTS - OPEN FORUM**

Pat Struzzieri stated that in 2009, she and her neighbors submitted a petition to request that the Town of Carmel take over the maintenance of Locust Court in Mahopac and asked what needed to be done to afford her and her neighbors the same consideration as Long Pond Association and Ossi Sport Club homeowners. Ms. Struzzieri spoke regarding the poor condition of Locust Court, its maintenance and repair history as well as her past communications with Town officials with regard to facilitating road improvements. Ms. Struzzieri expressed her concerns with regard to emergency services vehicle access to the homes on Locust Court.

Gregory Folchetti, Legal Counsel stated that he had spoken with Ms. Struzzieri in August with regard to an application for a road improvement district. He explained that even if a road is private, the Highway Department can maintain it to ensure emergency vehicle access to the dwellings.

Mr. Folchetti further explained that if the homeowners on Locust Court are stating that the Highway Department has maintained the road as a regular course of business over an extended period of time, then it is usually established through a court proceeding similar to what transpired with the Long Pond Association, which when dismissed, those homeowners petitioned for a road improvement district.

Mr. Folchetti went on to explain the process for the formation of a road improvement district and indicated that he had been advised by the Highway Superintendent Michael Simone that the issue with Locust Court is that its width cannot be improved to meet the road improvement district standards.

Discussion ensued at the conclusion of which, Supervisor Schmitt and Councilman Schneider stated that they would address the matter with Mr. Simone and report back to Ms. Struzzieri.

# **TOWN BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS - OPEN FORUM**

Supervisor Schmitt announced that hydrant flushing for Carmel Water Districts #2, #3 and #12 by Severn Trent Environmental Services, Inc. will begin on September 29, 2014. A schedule of dates for each road will be posted on the Town of Carmel's website as well as on Comcast channel 95 and Verizon channel 24. Customers may experience temporary fluctuation in pressure and/or temporary discoloration of water. Laundry should not be washed during this time.

Supervisor Schmitt announced that the Town Board's next Work Session will be held on Tuesday, September 23, 2014 in observance of Rosh Hashanah.
