TOWN BOARD MEETING TOWN HALL, MAHOPAC, N.Y.

A Regular Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Carmel was called to order by Supervisor Kenneth Schmitt on the 7th day of December 2011 at 7:17 p.m. at Town Hall, 60 McAlpin Avenue, Mahopac, New York. Members of the Town Board present by roll call were: Councilman Ravallo, Councilwoman McDonough and Supervisor Schmitt. Councilman Lombardi was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was observed prior to the start of official business and a moment of silence was observed to honor those serving in the United States Armed Forces as well as to commemorate the 70th anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor.

PUBLIC HEARING HELD TO HEAR OBJECTIONS TO ASSESSMENT ROLLS FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE IMPROVEMENTS OF THE SEWER AND WATER DISTRICTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012

With no one objecting to the public notice as read, Supervisor Schmitt opened the Public Hearing for public comment at 7:19 p.m. Seven (7) people were in attendance.

Councilman Ravallo commented that it has been brought to his attention that there are gaps in the assessment rolls for both the sewer and the water districts that may represent a significant source of funds. He stated that the situation should be corrected as soon as possible.

With no one else present wishing to be heard on the subject of the Public Hearing, on motion by Councilman Ravallo, seconded by Councilwoman McDonough, with all members of the Town Board present in agreement, the Public Hearing was closed at 7:21 p.m.

MINUTES OF TOWN BOARD MEETING HELD ON 11/2/11 - ACCEPT AS SUBMITTED BY THE TOWN CLERK

On motion by Councilwoman McDonough, seconded by Councilman Ravallo, with all members of the Town Board present voting "aye", the minutes of the Town Board meeting held on November 2, 2011 were accepted as submitted by the Town Clerk.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO INTER-MUNICIPAL AGREEMENT FOR THE EAST OF HUDSON (EOH) COALITION - NOT OFFERED

Councilman Ravallo stated that he will potentially be recusing himself from the vote on the following resolution. With no one offering the resolution at this time, Supervisor Schmitt explained that the resolution will not be considered at tonight's meeting. It will be included on the December 21, 2011 agenda when a full membership of the Town Board is expected.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Carmel has previously authorized the formation and creation of an intermunicipal organization entitled the East of Hudson ("EOH") Coalition and duly authorized entry into an intermunicipal agreement between the East of Hudson Municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the EOH Municipalities have since entered into such intermunicipal agreement (IMA) to form the EOH Coalition; and

WHEREAS, municipalities located in Dutchess County have indicated interest in joining the EOH Coalition by signing the IMA and have requested that one representative from Dutchess County be added to the executive committee thereof; and

WHEREAS on or about October 13, 2011, the EOH Coalition voted unanimously to add one representative from Dutchess County as a member of the EOH Coalition Executive Committee; and

WHEREAS, the vote by each member's representative is not binding on the participating municipality unless the municipal board approves the amendment to the IMA;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Carmel hereby approves the amendment of the IMA by the revision of paragraph 3.1 to read as follows: "There shall be an executive committee consisting of three representatives from Putnam County, three representatives from Westchester County and one representative from Dutchess County"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a new paragraph 3.1.5 is added to the IMA to read as follows: "One representative shall be elected by a majority vote of the Members from Dutchess County and shall serve for a term of two years."

Dear Ron:

In response to our recent discussions, this is offered to confirm the pricing for a NEW 100kw 480 volt 3 phase generator set for district #12. in lieu of merely relocating the existing Water District No. 2 generator to Jennifer Lane (which is specified under the current Bid Documents).

If the Town were to authorize this change in scope, my bid price for WD #12 would change from \$41,790 (in the current bid) to\$55500. This revised pricing is based on the following additional items we have discussed:

- 1) At the time the crane is on site to set the new generator at WD #2. I will use the crane to lift the existing WD #2 generator onto a truck provided by the Town, to be removed to any location of their choice for future use
- 2) leaving the existing generator pad at water #2, upon the removal of the existing generator
- the use of rigid pvc conduit in lieu of rgs conduit for generator installations, which is permitted by NEC.
- 4) This price includes modifications to district 12 wiring so as to allow both wells and the compressor circuit to be powered by the new generator (currently, the Bid Documents only require the powering of 1 well and 1 booster pump).

If this is acceptable to the Town, I am prepared to execute a Change Order to authorize this work co-incident with the execute of an overall contract for the purchase and installation of Generators and all of the enumerated Districts.

Supervisor Schmitt expressed his support for purchasing a new generator for Carmel Water District #12 in lieu of relocating the existing one from Carmel Water District #2. He explained that the generator from Carmel Water District #2 that was going to be installed in Carmel Water District #12 may now be utilized at Town Hall.

Gregory Folchetti, Legal Counsel added that the cost for the unit may be significantly lower because it does not reflect the fact that Carmel Water District #12 will be relieved from having to reimburse Carmel Water District #2 for the cost of the generator. A brief discussion regarding the matter was held.

Mr. Folchetti explained that the mitigation by the recommendation of the engineering department was to have the on-site representative from the manufacturer oversee the construction. The project was originally bid as one contract and one bid was received. The Town Board authorized rebidding the project and the engineering department recommended splitting the contract to be more cost effective.

Supervisor Schmitt stated that the installation has not gone out to bid yet.
