TOWN BOARD SPECIAL MEETING TOWN HALL, MAHOPAC, N.Y.

A Special Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Carmel was called to order by Supervisor Kenneth Schmitt on the 23rd day of February 2011 at 7:24 p.m. at Town Hall, 60 McAlpin Avenue, Mahopac, New York. Members of the Town Board present by roll call were: Councilman Ravallo, Councilman Lombardi, Councilwoman McDonough and Supervisor Schmitt.

Prior to the start of official business, the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was observed and a moment of silence was held for those serving in the United States Armed Forces, as well as for Poughkeepsie Police Officer John Falcone, a former Town of Carmel Police Department dispatcher, recently slain in the line of duty.

Supervisor Schmitt thanked Watson Pharmaceuticals, Inc. for their donation of a podium for the meeting room at Town Hall.

Supervisor Schmitt expressed his concern regarding the lack of decorum exhibited at recent Town Board meetings and spoke regarding the need for mutual respect. He requested that all in attendance practice civility and not engage in any offensive conduct.

Supervisor Schmitt stated that the Town Board held an interview of a candidate for the Planning Board at 6:45 p.m. and other interviews will be conducted at a future date.

<u>APPROPRIATION OF MONIES FROM THE HIGHWAY SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL</u> AND ROAD REPAIR RESERVE FUND AUTHORIZED - \$97,592.00

WHEREAS, the Town of Carmel has established a Snow and Ice Removal and Highway Repair Reserve Fund pursuant to GML Section 6F; and

WHEREAS, the Town experienced several heavy snow and ice storms during the month of January 2011 resulting in high labor and material costs; and

WHEREAS, it is intended that monies in the amount of \$97,592 in the Reserve Fund be used towards payment of these costs; and

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2011, a Public hearing was held at the Town Hall, 60 McAlpin Avenue, Mahopac, New York on the appropriation of \$97,592 from the Snow and Ice Removal and Highway Repair Reserve Fund for snow removal costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Carmel hereby appropriates \$97,592 from the Snow and Ice Removal and Highway Repair Reserve Fund for snow removal costs in fiscal year 2011; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Comptroller's Office is hereby authorized and instructed to make the necessary budget transfers to accomplish the intent of this resolution.
