### TOWN BOARD MEETING TOWN HALL, MAHOPAC, N.Y.

A Regular Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Carmel was called to order by Supervisor Michael Cazzari on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of April 2023 at 7:03 p.m. at Town Hall, 60 McAlpin Avenue, Mahopac, New York. Members of the Town Board present by roll call were: Councilman Baranowski, Councilman Lombardi, Councilwoman McDonough and Supervisor Cazzari. Councilman Schanil was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was observed prior to the start of official business. A moment of silence was held to honor those serving in the United States Armed Forces.

Supervisor Cazzari introduced Matt Slater, Assemblyman of the 94<sup>th</sup> District to speak about the New York State Budget, as well as other local issues. Assemblyman Slater stated that the transition to the State Assembly has been going very well. He wanted to remind all residents that his district office is still located in Brewster and is open to all who need assistance.

Regarding the State Budget, Assemblyman Slater said there isn't a state budget right now. The fiscal year for New York State ended on March 31, 2023. A budget extender was passed for an additional ten days which will expire on April 10, 2023. The biggest hold up with the State Budget is cashless bail. He said once the State Budget is finalized, we will know the final product.

Assemblyman Slater said that there has been a lot of discussion at the state level regarding other issues as well, including compact housing, environmental review processes, infrastructure, transit oriented development and veteran, Medicaid and school funding. Assemblyman Slater briefly reviewed each of these issues.

Discussion continued with Assemblyman Slater and the Town Board regarding the Governor's proposed revaluation mandate, the CHIPS funding (Consolidated Local Street and Highway Improvement Program) and cashless bail.

### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Erin Crowley, Putnam County Legislator inquired about the impact of the Governor's transit oriented development proposal as it relates to the bus stops within our town. Assemblyman Slater stated that the Governor's proposal does not include bus stops it only includes the Metro North Train locations.

## WATER EMERGENCY DECLARED PURSUANT TO SECTION 151-22 OF THE TOWN CODE - CARMEL WATER DISTRICT NUMBERS 1, 8, 10 AND 13

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Carmel, has been advised by Town Engineer Richard J. Franzetti, P.E., that a water emergency exists within the aforesaid water district numbers 1, 8, 10 and 13;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 151-22 (A) of the Town Code of the Town of Carmel, the Town Board, acting as Commissioners of Carmel Water Districts #1, #8, #10 and #13, hereby declares a water emergency with respect to and within Carmel Water Districts #1, #8, #10 and #13; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to Town Code §155-22 (B), during the period of said emergency as declared herein, the use of water for any of the following nonessential purpose(s) as enumerated in §155-22(C) shall be prohibited:

- (1) THE WASHING OF MOTOR VEHICLES, EXCEPT FOR WINDSHIELDS, MIRRORS AND THELIKE.
- (2) THE CLEANING OR WASHING OF THE OUTSIDE OF BUILDINGS OR OTHER STRUCTURES BY THE USE OF WATER OR STEAM.
- (3) THE BLEEDING OF SUPPLY LINES FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAINTAINING A CONSTANT FLOW TO PREVENT FREEZING.
- (4) THE FLOODING OF OUTDOOR SKATING RINKS.
- (5) THE OPERATION OF SWIMMING POOLS, PORTABLE AND OTHERWISE, EXCEPT

SWIMMING POOLS DESIGNED AND USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT. (Cont.)

- (6) THE USE OF AUTOMATIC PLUMBING FLUSH FIXTURES OR APPARATUS, AND THE MAINTENANCE OF CONSTANT FLOW FROM SHOWERS AND SIMILAR APPARATUS.
- (7) THE USE OF HOSE, SPOUT AND SIMILAR PRESSURE-BATHING APPARATUS, AND THE MAINTENANCE OF CONSTANT FLOW FROM SHOWERS AND SIMILAR APPARATUS.
- (8) THE NEW INSTALLATION OF REFRIGERATION AND/OR AIR-CONDITIONING EQUIPMENT REQUIRING THE USE OF WATER.
- (9) THE WATERING OF LAWNS AND PRIVATE GARDENS AND THE OPERATION OF ORNAMENTAL PONDS, POOLS AND FOUNTAINS.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk is directed to publish this resolution in the official newspapers of the Town and to post said resolution on the official bulletin Board of the Town.
