A Regular Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Carmel was called to order by Supervisor Kenneth Schmitt on the 20th day of January, 2021 at 7:05 p.m. at Town Hall, 60 McAlpin Avenue, Mahopac, New York. Members of the Town Board present by roll call were: Councilman Schanil, Councilman Barile, Councilman Lombardi, Councilwoman McDonough and Supervisor Schmitt.

TOWN BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS - OPEN FORUM

Supervisor Schmitt reported on the Town's recent efforts to comply with Governor Cuomo's Executive Order No. 203 issued in June of 2020 with respect to a Police Reform and Reinvention Collaborative for the State of New York. He announced that two public meetings will be held via Zoom platform in connection with the initiative, February 9, 2021 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. and March 2, 2021 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Supervisor Schmitt announced that the Town Board of the Town of Carmel is looking for a qualified person to fill a vacancy on the Environmental Conservation Board. Letters of interest and resumes should be directed to Supervisor Kenneth Schmitt by February 3, 2021.

Councilwoman McDonough reported on the progress of the updates to the Town of Carmel Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code revisions. She stated that the consultants working with the Town will be hosting a webinar in the near future with a date and time to be announced.

Councilman Lombardi addressed the recent illegal dumping occurring at a vacant parcel of land on Union Valley Road in Mahopac and spoke about his efforts to initiate its cleanup pursuant to the Town's property maintenance law. He reminded residents that bulk items may be disposed of by contacting their garbage company and that anyone caught dumping will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

Supervisor Schmitt proudly announced that the Town of Carmel has been ranked #4 on the list of safest midsized towns in New York State analyzed for violent and property crimes by researchers at AdvisorSmith. He acknowledged the Carmel Police Department, as well as the Putnam County Sheriff's Department and New York State Police for their contributions.

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Supervisor Schmitt announced that the Town Board will be meeting on February 2, 2021 with the consultants and contractors retained in connection with the revitalization projects underway in downtown Mahopac. Another meeting will be scheduled shortly thereafter to seek public input with regard to the projects' design.

All agenda items having been addressed, on motion by Councilman Lombardi, seconded by Councilwoman McDonough, with all Town Board members present in agreement, the meeting was adjourned at 7:37 p.m.
