A Regular Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Carmel was called to order by Supervisor Kenneth Schmitt on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2021 at 7:02 p.m. at Town Hall, 60 McAlpin Avenue, Mahopac, New York.
