Dear Mr. Karell:

On this date I delineated Peekskill Hollow Creek and the wetland associated with it as well as the pond located with this site as per Putnam Valley Town standards.

I placed 27 orange survey flags along the wetland and Peekskill Hollow Creek, 8 orange survey flags marked "I-1" thru "I-8" that outlines the small "island" located within Peekskill Hollow Creek and 10 orange survey flags (marked "P-1" thru" P-10") that delineate the pond. The creek flows southwest and is associated with a wetland immediately south of the subject parcel. I placed flags 1, 2, and 27 on the adjourning parcel to identify this widening of the wetland area.

Peekskill Hollow Creek is a NYSDEC protected stream and is rated as C (TS) which signifies it as a trout spawning stream. The Creek also flows into the Hudson River. Any work within the creek or its banks will require a NYSDEC stream permit.

The pond was created and is fed from runoff and diverted drainage to the east and is not associated with the creek other than an overflow pipe from the pond to the creek.

The soils on this site are rated as Charlton and Pompton series, which are not considered hydric. There are no protected species on the property but threatened bat species are within 5 miles of the site.
