Good Morning,

Recently members of our department have proposed a bylaw change in an effort to be able to accept more members into the department. We have proposed a bylaw change to allow non-residents of our fire protection district to join as active members. Our current bylaw reads as follows:

Article VI - Membership Section 3 - Non-Resident Member Current:

Any person not less than seventeen (17) years of age nor more than sixty-five (65) years of age whose place of employment is within the Mahopac Fire Protection District and who has been so employed for a minimum of twelve months preceding the date of application, may join the Department as a Non-resident Active Member. All rules and regulations of the Department must be adhered to in order to continue membership in the Department except for the residency requirement. 12/03/87

Our certificate of incorporation states that the corporation "proposes to set within the Town of Carmel, County of Putnam, and State of New York, therefore we feel removing the protection district residency requirement to allow for us to accept members within the Town of Carmel is a simple inhouse bylaw change.

However, we have also recently had people express interest in joining from outside the Town of Carmel, even potentially outside of Putnam County. Based on experience with previous Supervisors and Town Boards we feel prior to entertaining this and expanding the Active membership requirements beyond the Town of Carmel we need an interpretation of the meaning of the word vicinity as referenced in Not-for-profit corporation Law Section 1402 Fire Corporations.

The definition of vicinity is a surrounding, adjacent, or nearby area. We felt this required a mileage limitation placed on it that would allow for a reasonable response time, As you will see in the proposed bylaw below we interpret it as being defined as residence or the location of their usual occupation is within four and a half (4.5) road miles travel distance to the Mahopac Volunteer Fire Dept. Headquarters, 741 Route 6, Mahopac, N.Y., by using electronic mapping.

Not for profit corporation Law Section 1402 Fire Corporations states:

- (c) Appointment of firefighters.
- (3) In towns outside of villages and fire districts, the consent of a majority of the members of the town board to the formation of a fire corporation shall constitute an appointment of the persons named in the certificate of incorporation as town firefighters. Thereafter, other eligible persons may be elected as members pursuant to the by-laws of the fire corporation, but the election of a member must be approved by the town board of each town which consented to the formation of the fire corporation. Such a person shall be a resident of the territory specified in the certificate of incorporation or of territory outside such boundaries which is afforded fire protection by the fire corporation pursuant to a contract for fire protection under which a cash consideration is received by the corporation or for which negotiations for renewal of such a contract are pending. The membership of any volunteer member shall terminate when he or she ceases to be a resident of such inside or outside territory, except that the corporation may authorize his or her continued membership where he or she notifies the secretary of the fire corporation (a) that he or she plans to change his or her residence to a territory which is not in such inside or outside territory, and (b) that by reason of his or her residence in the vicinity or his or her usual occupation he or she will be available to render active service as a volunteer firefighter in either such inside or such outside territory. Voting for such authorization shall be pursuant to the by-laws. Such authorization shall not become effective unless approved by resolution of the town board of each town which consented to the formation of the corporation. Any membership so continued shall terminate when the member can no longer meet the requirements of this subparagraph. A person who

cannot meet the residence requirements of this subparagraph may be elected to membership as a volunteer member if by reason of his or her residence in the vicinity or his or her usual occupation he or she will be available to render active service as a volunteer firefighter in such inside or outside territory

The proposed change to the bylaws is as follows:

Section 3 - Non-resident Member Requirements

- A. A person, not less than seventeen (17) years of age nor more than sixty five (65) years of age, may be admitted to active membership, in accordance with Article VI, Section 4 if their residence or their place of employment is in the vicinity, as per New York State Not for Profit Corporation Law 1402, provided the roster does not show a full membership and, the non-resident member roll does not exceed forty five percent (45%).
- B. Vicinity is defined as their residence or location of their usual occupation is within four and a half (4.5) road miles travel distance to the Mahopac Volunteer Fire Dept. Headquarters, 741 Route 6, Mahopac, N.Y., by using electronic mapping, as determined by the committee in Article VI, Section 4. For place of employment, the committee shall procure a document from the applicant's employer that he/she will be available to render active service and respond during work hours to fire alarms and/or ambulance calls.
- C. Such member shall be entitled to all active member privileges as long as long as they continue to reside or be employed at the location at the time of their application or if they relocate to a residence or place of employment that will meet Sub-section B, above.
- D. A member, who was admitted to membership as a non-resident, under Article VI, Section 3, who fails to continue to meet the vicinity requirement of Sub-section B, is dropped from the rolls.

Although we have two other stations on the outlying boarders of our protection district, we chose Headquarters because of the possibility to accept EMS only members who would need to respond to Headquarters.

Since the Town Board has to approve the roles of the Mahopac Volunteer Fire Department in order to extend the Worker's Compensation Benefits to our members, we feel it is important to seek your interpretation and approval for the above change so that in the event individuals names with addresses outside of the Town of Carmel come before you, you are aware that this is why.

Please be advised, since 2014 the Police Department has participated along with the Town of Kent and the Putnam County Sheriff's Office in access to the Leads Online database, an information system detailing transaction data from regulated second hand property merchants.

This database access is up for renewal as of January 1, 2024. Putnam County, as in the past, will be the main access entity for the database, and as a result pay Leads Online, LLC a total amount of \$37,593 for the renewal period of 1/1/2024 - 12/31/2027. As per the agreement, the Town of Carmel will reimburse Putnam County an amount of \$8,353.43 for the term of the renewal period. Copy of Putnam County agreement attached for your review.

CPD Detectives have utilized this database a number of times in the past in property crime investigations, and its usefulness has been shown in identifying potential burglary suspects and returning stolen property to owners. I recommend that we continue our agreement with Putnam County to maintain access to the Leads Online database.

Therefore I respectfully request a Town Board resolution to renew our participation with Putnam County in the Leads Online database, and authorize the Police Department to remit an amount to Putnam County not to exceed \$8,353.43 for the term of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2026 for continued database access.

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter confirms the following agreement has been reached between Town of Carmel Police Department (hereinafter "CARMEL") and the COUNTY OF PUTNAM, acting by and through the Putnam County Sheriff's Department (hereinafter "COUNTY").

COUNTY has entered into an agreement with LEADSONLINE LLC, to provide the COUNTY with electronic access to an electronic reporting and criminal investigation system for receiving Data for use of Law Enforcement Officers in their official duties. COUNTY agrees to allow CARMEL access to LEADSONLINE LLC's electronic reporting and criminal investigation system, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. COUNTY entered into a three (3) year agreement with LEADSONLINE LLC commencing on January 1, 2024 and terminating on December 31, 2026, hereinafter referred to as the "AGREEMENT". The parties agree that CARMEL will have access to the electronic system described above during the term of the AGREEMENT.
- 2. COUNTY will pay LEADSONLINE LLC directly for the services rendered under the AGREEMENT as follows:
  - i. TWELVE THOUSAND FORTY-SIX DOLLARS (\$12,046.00) for the first year; and
  - ii. TWELVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND SEVEN DOLLARS (\$12,407.00) for the second year; and
  - iii. TWELVE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY DOLLARS (\$12,780.00) for the third year.

THIRD: The term of this Rider to Agency Agreement shall be for three (3) years, commencing on January 1, 2024, and shall terminate December 31, 2026, unless otherwise agreed to, in writing, by the parties hereto, or terminated in accordance with the termination paragraphs numbered 5.3 and 5.4 of the attached Agency Agreement.

<u>FOURTH</u>: During the term of this Rider to Agency Agreement, for services rendered according to paragraph "SECOND" hereof, CONTRACTOR shall be paid as follows:

- A. TWELVE THOUSAND FORTY-SIX DOLLARS (\$12,046.00) for the first year; and
- B. TWELVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND SEVEN DOLLARS (\$12,407.00) for the second year; and

Prior to the making of any payments hereunder, the COUNTY may, at its option, audit all files and disbursement records of the CONTRACTOR as are reasonably pertinent to this Contract to substantiate the basis for payment, including but not limited to the CONTRACTOR'S records of its financial transactions with the COUNTY. The CONTRACTOR'S files and records shall be
