ADDENDUM NO. 1

The following revisions are to be made and incorporated into the Contract Documents:

- 1. In response to the following questions:
 - a. If work is for TOC infrastructure, what permits are required if any?

<u>Response:</u> Electrical permit only see response to (g).

b. Does concrete base prep need scheduled inspection?

<u>Response:</u> Inspections will be performed by the Engineering Department

c. What is the allowable size of the finished enclosure? Are we just to keep it to the minimum requirements? I figured 16-0' x 9-0' enclosure which gives 36 inches all around gen-set. Minimum requirements as there is not a lot of space at this location

<u>Response:</u> Fencing dimensions shall be 14' x 9'.

d. The fence and gate detail show 2 different heights, 6 ft & 7 ft; please confirm.

<u>Response:</u> The correct height is 6 ft

e. The fence detail is missing pipe sizes for cross pipes and top / bottom pipes, please confirm if 1-1/2 pipe is acceptable.

Response: 11/2" is acceptable

f. The concrete pad detail shows #4 rebar grid, is #4 wire grid mat acceptable?

<u>Response:</u> #4 wire grid mat is acceptable

g. Do I need an electrical permit for the alteration on TOC infrastructure?

<u>Response:</u> Yes

h. Regarding the fence, is the green barrier insert required?

<u>Response:</u> No.

i. When and how can we schedule a visit to the site?

<u>Response:</u> There is no planned site visit scheduled. The site is located at the intersection of Senior Avenue and Ellen Avenue is accessible for anyone interested in visiting.

j. Are we expected to put fencing only around the generator, or should we extend the fencing to encompass the entire site? (Generator, pit and electric service).

<u>Response:</u> Fencing is required only around the generator.

k. Will someone be doing a survey to make sure we stay on whatever easement the town has there? Will we be responsible for it or should we not worry about it?

<u>Response:</u> Limits will be provided to the selected proposer.

I. Do we need to worry about the proximity of the fencing to the road?

<u>Response:</u> The fencing shall be placed 2 ft off the edge of the road.

m. Are we required to put up bollards?

<u>Response:</u> No.
