SIDE LETTER OF AGREEMENT

It is hereby agreed by and between the Town of Carmel (the "Town") and Local 456, LB.T. (the "Union") as follows:

- A retirement incentive of \$20,000 shall be extended to all unit members, who meet all of the following conditions:
 - a. Such unit member shall submit an irrevocable letter of resignation for purposes of retirement by the unit member with an effective retirement date no earlier than March 26, 2014 and no later than April 1, 2014, to be received by the Town Supervisor on or before the close of business on January 17, 2014;
 - Such unit member shall continue to actively work in their positions for 35 hours per week or more until March 26, 2014 but no later than April 1, 2014;
 - c. Such unit member has fifteen (15) years of service with the Town and is eligible to retire under the New York State Employees' Retirement System; and
 - d. Such unit member shall retire in accordance with the New York State Employees' Retirement System as of the unit member's effective retirement date.
- Should an employee be eligible for the above retirement incentive, such payment shall be made payable within thirty days after the employee's actual retirement date.
- 3. This incentive shall replace any and all prior retirement incentives offered by the Town that may still be in effect.
- The retirement incentive shall not apply to unit members who have already submitted letters of resignation for purposes of retirement prior to January 1, 2014.
- This Agreement sunsets effective April 1, 2014, and shall be considered non-precedent setting and cannot be referred to by either party as evidence of a past practice.
- 6. This Agreement shall become effective upon the approval of the Carmel Town Board.

Nick Fannin inquired with regard to the proposal of Pittsburgh Tank and Tower Maintenance Company, which water storage tanks in Water Districts #2, #3, #8, #9 and #14 will be inspected.

Supervisor Schmitt stated that all of the water storage tanks will be inspected.

Mr. Fannin asked if there were any other proposals solicited.

Supervisor Schmitt stated that there were not and that the Request for Proposals fell under the threshold for professional services.

Mr. Fannin inquired about the settlement in connection with "NL&M Holding Corp. vs. the Town of Carmel, Town Board of The Town of Carmel, and the Board of Assessment Review of The Town of Carmel".

Supervisor Schmitt explained that this settlement pertained to a certiorari proceeding commenced by a commercial property owner to challenge his assessment.

Councilman Lombardi added that the settlement of the litigation had been negotiated by the Town Assessor and Special Counsel who have recommended its approval.

Gregory Folchetti, Legal Counsel noted that once the parties have executed the settlement agreement, there will be a judicial sign-off.

Don Schipf inquired about the cost in connection with the proposal for payroll services.

Councilman Schneider stated that it was just over \$25,000.00.

Mr. Schipf inquired about the side letter of agreement with I.B.T. Local 456 regarding the 2014 Retirement Incentive.

Councilman Lombardi explained that the Retirement Incentive will benefit the Town by saving the cost of the employee's salary and benefits from the end of March until October. He stated that although there is a cost associated therewith, it is outweighed by the savings.

Supervisor Schmitt pointed out that the Town Board would not have agreed to offer the retirement incentive if the Highway Superintendent had not agreed to keep the positions vacant and if it did not result in a significant savings to the Town.

Mr. Schipf suggested that rather than offering a retirement incentive of \$20,000.00, the Town Board offer additional years of service to the employee which would be of no cost to the Town as it becomes a State cost. Discussion ensued.

Councilman Lupinacci concluded that because there are multiple methods of offering a retirement incentive, in the future, Mr. Schipf's suggestion could be considered.
