### SUBSTITUTION OF COLLATERAL IN CONNECTION WITH PERFORMANCE BOND AUTHORIZED - NICHOLAS LUPINACCI - "LUPI CAR WASH" - TM #75.19-1-10

WHEREAS a performance bond in the amount of \$148,240.00 was previously posted by Nicholas Lupinacci ("Applicant") in accordance with the Land Subdivision and/or Zoning Regulations for Tax Map #75.19-1-10, and with respect to the Site Plan entitled "Lupi Car Wash" last revised May 28, 2010 and

WHEREAS the Applicant has submitted a new letter of credit no. 530000261in the amount of \$148,240.00 issued by Mahopac National Bank in form and content which has been approved by the Planning Board attorney; and

WHEREAS the Applicant has requested that the Mahopac National Bank Letter of Credit no. 530000261 be substituted as collateral for the completion of the approved site improvements;

#### STIPULATION OF AGREEMENT

IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between the Town of Carmel (hereinafter

"Town") and the Town of Carmel Police Benevolent Association, Inc. (hereinafter

"PBA") as follows:

- The PBA recognizes that the Town, through it Chief of Police shall assign patrol
  officer(s) to the Special Conditions Unit and to remove such patrol officer(s) from
  that assignment. Prior to the removal of the patrol officer(s) from the assignment,
  the patrol officer(s) and his/her union representative shall be afforded the
  opportunity to be heard by the Town Board.
- The Town and the PBA agree that the annual stipend for any officer(s) assigned to the Special Conditions Unit shall be Two Thousand (\$2,000) Dollars, payable in bi-annual installments of \$1,000 (July and December of each year).
- 3. The Town and the PBA agree that patrol officer(s) who are assigned to the Special Conditions Unit shall receive an annual clothing allowance in the amount of Six Hundred and Fifty (\$650) Dollars, which shall be paid in January of each year following the assignment to the Special Conditions Unit.
- The Town and the PBA agree that the annual stipend and the annual clothing allowance shall be pro rated for the 2010 calendar year.
