## <u>PUTNAM COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH PUBLIC AWARENESS - ZIKA VIRUS UPDATE</u>

Putnam County Department of Health Sanitarian Shawn Rogan and Public Health Nurse Jean Ralston, RN gave an educational presentation on the Zika virus, a disease transmitted primarily by the bite of an infected mosquito. The illness is usually mild with symptoms lasting for several days to a week and does not require treatment. However, Zika virus infection during pregnancy can cause microcephaly, as well as other severe fetal brain defects. Prevention methods for individuals, such as the application of insect repellent when outdoors were recommended along with methods of mosquito control, which include the removal of all standing water, the breeding site for mosquitoes, in flower pots, bird baths, cans or other places where water can collect.
