Supervisor Schmitt announced that Putnam County will be holding their Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day on May 6, 2017 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the Fahnestock Park Canopus Beach Parking Lot on Route 301 in Kent. The Putnam County Department of Health should be contacted for further information and to register.

Supervisor Schmitt announced to the property owners in Carmel Sewer Districts #1 and #3 that Green Mountain Pipeline Services will commence lining of their collection systems the week of May 8, 2017. He detailed the proposed schedule for service interruptions and advised those affected by the work to check the Town's website or contact the Engineering Department for additional information.

Supervisor Schmitt commended the Carmel Police Department, the New York State Police Department as well as the Putnam County Sheriff's Department for their diligent efforts in connection with the investigation into the recent tragic homicide that occurred in the Town. He stated that the law enforcement officials have determined that the individual who committed the crime has subsequently committed suicide.
