**TOWN BOARD SPECIAL MEETING
TOWN HALL, MAHOPAC, N.Y.**

A Special Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Carmel was called to order by Deputy Supervisor Frank Lombardi on the 13th day of February 2013 at 7:17 p.m. at Town Hall, 60 McAlpin Avenue, Mahopac, New York. Members of the Town Board present by roll call were: Councilman Schneider, Councilman Lupinacci and Councilman Lombardi. Councilwoman McDonough and Supervisor Schmitt were absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was observed prior to the start of official business. A moment of silence was observed to honor those serving in the United States Armed Forces as well as in memory of the recent passing of Councilwoman McDonough's brother-in-law, Robert McDonough.
