### PERFORMANCE BOND CALLED OF 3J-MAC REAL ESTATE, LLC IN REGARD TO THE SITE PLAN IMPROVEMENTS PROPOSED AT 834 ROUTE SIX, MAHOPAC

WHEREAS 3J-Mac Real Estate, LLC has failed to complete the improvements called for in the approved site plan for the premises at 834 Route Six, Mahopac, NY, Town of Carmel Tax Map No. 65.17-1-38 and/or has failed to comply with all the terms and conditions of its site plan approval with respect to the performance of the improvements called for thereon; and

WHEREAS 3J-Mac Real Estate, LLC posted a performance bond, assignment of Mahopac National Bank, Account # 021-15892-4, in the amount of \$51,453 indemnifying and guaranteeing the Town of Carmel against the failure of 3J-Mac Real Estate, LLC to perform said obligations;

Supervisor Schmitt stated that the referenced property was located at the site of the former Mahopac Mower Mart. Discussion was held between the members of the Town Board and Gregory Folchetti, Legal Counsel, with regard to the process of calling the bond.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Judy Ravnitzky inquired if the owners of the property at 834 Route Six would be given an opportunity to complete the work called for in their site plan.

Mr. Folchetti explained that the applicant still owns the lot. The Town's major concern is that the improvements to the premises are completed.

Ms. Ravnitzky praised the Historic Red Mills Park and with regard to the source of the funding for its proposed fencing, inquired about the account balance in the parkland trust account.

Supervisor Schmitt explained that the amount is available in the Comptroller's office. A brief discussion ensued regarding the parkland trust account.

Michael Barile commented that the amount posted for the site plan improvements for the premises at 834 Route Six would not be sufficient to cover the cost to complete the required work. He suggested that upon calling the bond, the Town Board deposit the funds in the bank, have the Highway Department secure the road, and commence a lawsuit against the property owner to obtain the remaining funds that will be necessary to complete the work.

Bill McCormack thanked the members of the Town Board for moving forward with the improvements to the Historic Red Mills Park.

Jerry Ravnitzky encouraged residents to participate in the Public Hearing scheduled for June 22, 2011 for the purpose of establishing maximum rates with respect to residential garbage and refuse collections.

Mr. Ravnitzky suggested that the Zoning Compliance Committee would benefit from the addition of new members and directed interested persons to contact the Supervisor's office.

#### TOWN BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Councilwoman McDonough reported on the recent meeting of the Zoning Compliance Committee, noting that discussion was held regarding sign legislation and garbage legislation compliance. Also discussed was the concept of a "litter free" month in conjunction with local law enforcement as well as enacting steep slope legislation, among other topics.

Supervisor Schmitt reported on the progress of the remediation of a pile of contaminated soil resulting from the removal of oil storage tanks located on Route 6 in Mahopac.

Councilman Lombardi reported as a result of the efforts of the Town of Carmel and State of New York, in addition to the multitude of tires removed from the former junkyard on Union Valley Road, the rusted and abandoned vehicles have been removed. Discussion regarding the matter was held.

Councilman Lombardi reminded residents that a second Mahopac Central School District budget vote will be held on June 21, 2011 from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Supervisor Schmitt invited the public to attend the Mahopac Sports Association's 1<sup>st</sup> Annual 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Lacrosse Invitational Tournament on June 18, 2011 at the Mahopac High School, from 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Supervisor Schmitt announced that on June 16, 2011, he will be traveling with a contingent of first responders to JFK Airport to pick up the steel beams and other artifacts that will be included in the Town of Carmel 911 Memorial. They will be returning to Town Hall at approximately 1:45 p.m. at which time Father Brennan from St. John the Evangelist Church and Rabbi Hammerman from Temple Beth Shalom will bless the artifacts at a brief ceremony.
